Application Rules

1. One application/submission per artist.
2. Each logo must include "New Harmony Bicentennial" and "1814-2014"
3. Logo submission and application with signed copyright waiver must be hand-delivered or postmarked no later than **November 15, 2011**.
4. Artwork should be submitted in paper form and CD or digital image.
5. The printed version of the logo must be clearly marked with the artist's name, address and phone number on the BACK of the artwork. For judging purposes, your name or any other identifying item may not appear on the artwork submitted for the contest.
6. The original design must be 8 ½ X 11. Digital images must be at least 300 dpi. **The artwork should be a print ready design that will print well on a variety of mediums** such as fabric, paper, glossy paper, plastics, etc.
7. Artwork should be the artist's original work and not a photograph. Artwork will be disqualified if it is plagiarized from another source, infringes on copyright laws, or is otherwise misrepresented.
8. Limit of five (5) colors should be used in the artwork with black counting as a color.
9. Whenever possible, the artist will be given credit for the logo design; however, there is no guarantee that it can be done in every case.

If submitted designs do not meet the criteria or are deemed by the judges not to achieve our goals, we reserve the right to continue the search for a new design by continuing this competition or by other means.
