**IMPORTANTANT NOTICE TO CUSTOMER’S REGARDING
NATURAL GAS BURIED PIPING**

This notice is being provided in accordance with Rule 49 CFR 192.16 of the United States Department of Transportation (“DOT Rule”).

In accordance with the “DOT Rule” listed above, the Town is hereby giving notice to all customers who have buried natural gas piping that is not maintained by the New Harmony Gas Department of the following information:

1. If the customer’s buried pipeline is not maintained, it may be subject to the potential hazards of corrosion and leakage.
2. Buried gas piping should be:
 - a. periodically inspected for leaks
 - b. periodically inspected for corrosion if the piping is metallic
 - c. repaired if any unsafe condition is discovered
3. When excavating near buried gas piping, the piping should be located in advance and the excavation done by hand.
4. Plumbers and heating contractors can assist in locating, inspecting and repairing the customer’s buried piping.

For your guidance in determining whether this notice applies to you, please be informed that in most cases the Town of New Harmony, Indiana maintains buried gas piping from the main (generally located near the street curb) up to the gas meter on the customer’s premises. In addition, if the piping leaving the meter up to the principal gas utilization equipment is above ground when entering the customer’s premises, the rule does not apply. However, any customer that has any lines (secondary lines) that branch off of the principal gas line and goes underground, such as a garage, BBQ grill, pool, et cetera, the above listed precautions should be noted.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION
EXCESS FLOW VALVES

The Town of New Harmony, Indiana, in accordance with the Minimum Federal Pipeline Safety Standards 49 CFR 192.383, hereby provides notification that an excess flow valve meeting the performance standards of 192.381 is available for installation in your gas service line. The cost of such installation is the responsibility of the customer.

Excess flow valves are designed to shut off the flow of natural gas should your service line be severed. This would provide for added safety by reducing the flow of gas through the service line.

The interruption of gas service may be caused by natural disaster, ground movement or third party damages.

The estimated cost to install such a device is \$150.00 for 1 in. IPS plastic service line. Costs for other sizes will be provided on an as requested basis.

The customer will bear all costs associated with the maintenance and replacement of such device should you request it to be installed. We estimate the replacement cost to be \$500.00 should it be required.
