

NOVEMBER 19, 2019

The Town Council met in regular session at the Town Hall at 8:30 a.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by President Blaylock.

Present were: BLAYLOCK, ALSOP, FLANDERS, and WATSON along with Clerk-Treasurer Karla Atkins and Attorney Erin Bauer.

The following visitors were present: Tom Williams, Dan Barton, Sally Denning, Dan Mason, Paul Goodman, and Sue Krozel.

Councilman Watson made and Alsop seconded a motion the minutes of the previous regular meeting be approved. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Councilman Watson made and Alsop seconded a motion the minutes of the November 14, 2019, Special Meeting be approved. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Councilman Alsop made and Watson seconded a motion the employees' health insurance with Anthem be renewed for 2020 as proposed by the company. The new plan will be slightly different from the current plan. All were in favor. Motion carried.

President Blaylock reported the salary ordinance for elected officials will need to be adopted in December to be effective January 1. He asked members to think about what they wish to do.

Councilman Watson made and Alsop seconded a motion that approval be given to pay the registration fee for those desiring to attend the newly elected officials training in Evansville on December 9. All were in favor. Motion carried. Those wishing to attend should notify the Clerk-Treasurer by 4 p.m. on November 21.

Dan Mason reported a scope and priorities for Historic New Harmony for 2020 are being developed. He would like to present this to Council once it is complete, at either a regular or special meeting. Mr. Mason introduced new employee Paul Goodman, who was in attendance at the meeting.

Councilman Alsop made and Flanders seconded a motion that a sewer fee waiver be approved for 629 South St., as requested by the property owner, Carlene VanLaningham, at the previous meeting. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Councilman Watson made and Alsop seconded a motion the claims be allowed and the Clerk pay the same. All were in favor. Motion carried.

President Blaylock announced the 2020-1 Community Crossings Matching Grant application is due in January. Council is looking into a list of streets to include in that application.

Councilman Wade made and Alsop seconded a motion the meeting be adjourned. All were in favor. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 8:41 a.m.
